SUBJECT: Imposition of a curfew

WHEREAS the Council met at a special meeting in Chisasibi, Quebec on this 11th day of January 2021;

WHEREAS the Cree Board of Health and Social Services has identified an outbreak of COVID-19 in Eeyou Istchee that were tied to gatherings;


WHEREAS over the holiday season, Cree from Chisasibi travelled to other communities and may have had contact, direct or indirect, with those who have since tested positive or will test for COVID-19;

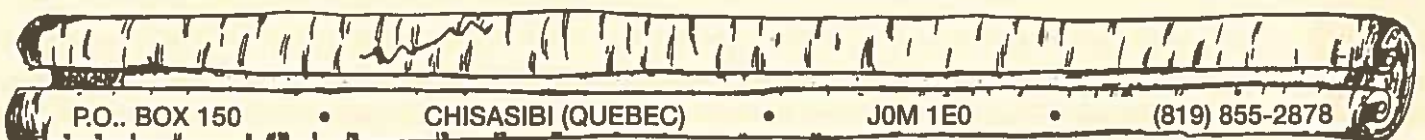
WHEREAS COVID-19 may be transmitted at indoor gatherings and anywhere where people are in close proximity with others;

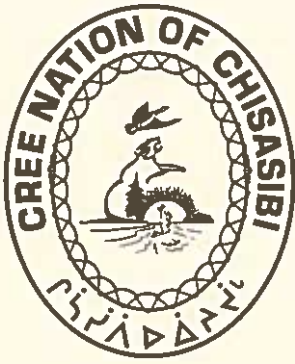
WHEREAS the Emergency Preparedness Committee and Emergency Operations Committee, dealing with the responses to COVID-19 have recommended imposing a curfew to prevent unnecessary gatherings and to curb potential outbreaks;

WHEREAS house parties and gatherings in homes are prohibited during curfew and individuals may not be at any other person's home or outside their place of residence during curfew except as permitted in this resolution;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED:

THAT pursuant to Law No. 2021-01 amending Law No. 2017-003, CNC hereby issues an order imposing a curfew from 10:00 pm until 6:00 am commencing on January 11, 2021 at 10:00 pm and ending on February 8, 2021 at 6:00 am, unless rescinded earlier;

THAT any person found outside between 10pm and 6am must inform the EEPF of their starting point and destination and the reasons for being outside;

THAT no person may be outside their place of residence or at any other person's residence during curfew except as permitted herein;

THAT individuals may be outside during curfew to attend work, provide assistance to a member of their immediate family who lives alone or to seek medical assistance;

THAT the Eeyou Eenou Police Force will be provided a copy of this resolution and the Amended Law in order to enforce the curfew;

THAT any individual contravening the curfew may be subject to a fine of \$500, \$750 for a second offence and \$1,000 for each subsequent offence.
