Cree Nation of Chisasibi Education of Completion Awards (Revised June 3, 2014)

Criteria:

1. Be a beneficiary of the JBNQA
2. Be a recognized member of the Cree Nation of Chisasibi including the Inuit of Chisasibi at the beginning, duration and upon completion of the program of study
3. Applications to the fund must be submitted by the concerned student
4. The appropriate documentation must be enclosed with the request (i.e., official transcripts and diplomas)

Graduation Categories for Awards:

Awards are only granted for completed programs; those who have partially completed programs are ineligible to apply. The following are the various categories under which a student is eligible to apply for an award:

1. Upon successful completion of a secondary program leading to a secondary V diploma or attestation of completion in the case of vocational programs whether in the youth sector or in Continuing Education.
2. Upon successful completion of a 2-year program as indicated in the course calendar for students attending CEGEP, community College or equivalent.
3. Upon successful completion of a 3-year program as indicated in the course calendar for students attending CEGEP, community College or equivalent.
4. Upon successful completion of a university level Certificate Program for students attending an accredited university.
5. Upon successful completion of a 3- year or 4-year Bachelor Degree Program for students attending an accredited university.
6. Upon successful completion of a Graduate level diploma or certificate (Post-bachelor's additional concentration) as indicated in the course calendar.
7. Upon successful completion of a Master's Degree Program for students attending an accredited University.
8. Upon successful completion of a Doctoral Degree Program for students attending an accredited university.
9. Upon successful completion of a Certificate or Diploma for students attending an accredited institution other than University (programs of 28 weeks or more).

Deadlines:

Applications must be made to the CNC after degree/certificate/diploma (non-cumulative) completion. The Corporate Secretary will table applications as they are received for approval at next council meeting. The applicants will have 1 year from the date of graduation or date on transcript or date on degree/certificate/diploma (non-cumulative) to apply for the Education Completion Award.

Applications:

Applications are available at the Cree Nation of Chisasibi administrative Centre and on-line.

Amounts:

These amounts may be adjusted from time to time. If amounts are adjusted by the CNC, then those amounts in effect at the time a diploma/degree/certificate is granted will apply.
