BOIL WATER ADVISORY FOR CHISASIBI

Chisasibi, Tuesday, May 7, 2024, 7:00 p.m. - Cree Nation of Chisasibi is advising residents of Chisasibi to **boil their tap water** before drinking it due to discolouration. A **BOIL WATER ADVISORY** is in effect until further notice.

To avoid possible illness, **bring the water to a rolling boil for at least one minute.** Let the water cool down before using or drinking it.

Until further notice, use **boiled water** or another source of safe drinking water (such as bottled water) for:

- Drinking;
- Making ice cubes, juices or other mixes;
- Preparing baby food or infant formula;
- Making coffee or tea;
- Preparing food, including washing fruits and vegetables;
- Gargling or brushing teeth or dentures.

Bathing and Hand Washing

- Toddlers and young children: Give sponge baths.
- Adults, teens and older children can safely take showers.
- Tap water can be used to wash your hands.

Washing and Cleaning.

- Laundry can be done as usual.
