**TITLE:** DECK HAND – Tourism Boat (Coastal)

**DEPARTMENT:** ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

**CORE FUNCTION:** The Deckhand will be under the General Direction of Tourism Coordinator. The Deck Hand will be responsible in assisting with various tasks on the vessels.

### **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Handling and preparation of the Tourism boat;
- Must know about Safety on the boat;
- Should be able to swim;
- Should be aware of a Cree traditional lifestyle;
- Knowledge of hunting, fishing, trapping and traditional activities;
- To be knowledgeable on how to keep a boat very clean and neat and what type of cleaners must be used on what surfaces;
- To have a knowledge of small boat handling safety of guests and crew;
- To have a knowledge of ship's inventory of all items related to deck hand's work and mate's and captain work;
- To be ready at all times to conduct fire, man over board or other drills as the captain sees fit and necessary;
- Prepare vessel prior to departure;
- Ensure that health and safety requirements of everyone on board are met;
- Understand weather and tide conditions in local area;
- Be attentive to the demands and requirements of community members;
- Be a strong communicator and be able to say 'no' when appropriate;



- Knowledge of first aid, evacuation and emergency procedures;
- Perform any other tasks required by Supervisor;
- One must possess knowledge of the history of Chisasibi and its surrounding region.
- Maintain a positive, customer focused image of the Cree Nation of Chisasibi and respond to user concerns, problems, or complaints in a timely manner.
- Will represent the **Cree Nation of Chisasibi** in a polite and professional manner when dealing with community members.
- May be required to provide assistance to other departments.
- Perform all other related duties as requested by immediate supervisor.

- Must have excellent knowledge of both the Cree & English languages
