TITLE: PLUMBER – PUBLIC BUILDINGS

DEPARTMENT: PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

CORE FUNCTION: Under the Supervision and direction of the Director of Public Works for the Cree Nation of Chisasibi, but more specifically under the Public Building Maintenance Supervisor. The Plumber shall be responsible for inspecting, repairing, maintaining, altering and installing all plumbing systems within the Cree Nation of Chisasibi public buildings. He/she ensures that all plumbing systems operate safely, efficiently, and in compliance with applicable codes, regulations, and safety standards. The Plumber performs preventive maintenance, responds to emergency repairs, and supports the overall maintenance of public facilities.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Install, maintain, repair, and replace water supply, drainage, sewage, venting, and piping systems.
- Diagnose plumbing problems and determine appropriate corrective actions.
- Repair and replace faucets, sinks, toilets, urinals, showers, water heaters, pumps, valves, and other plumbing fixtures.
- Clear clogged drains, sewer lines, and plumbing systems using appropriate equipment and techniques.
- Conduct regular inspections of plumbing systems to identify maintenance needs and prevent failures.
- Perform leak detection and repair work on water distribution systems.
- Test plumbing systems to ensure proper operation and compliance with applicable standards.
- Maintain and repair hot water and heating systems as required.

- Develop and carry out preventive maintenance schedules for plumbing equipment and systems.
 - Monitor plumbing infrastructure and recommend repairs or upgrades when necessary.
 - Maintain accurate maintenance records, inspection reports, and work orders.
 - Ensure all plumbing tools and equipment are maintained in good working condition.
 - Assist with general building maintenance activities when required.
 - Coordinate with other maintenance staff and contractors on repair and renovation projects.
 - Support emergency response efforts related to water leaks, flooding, sewer backups, and other facility emergencies.
 - Participate in after-hours emergency call-outs as required.
 - Follow all occupational health and safety regulations, policies, and procedures.
 - Identify and report safety hazards and potential risks.
 - Ensure compliance with applicable plumbing, building, and environmental regulations.
 - Complete work orders, maintenance logs, and inspection reports accurately and in a timely manner.
 - Must have computer experience and willing to take training.
 - Assist in preparing maintenance reports and documentation.
 - Maintain a positive, customer focused image of the Cree Nation of Chisasibi and respond to user concerns, problems, or complaints in a timely manner.
 - Will represent the **Cree Nation of Chisasibi** in a polite and professional manner when dealing with community members.
 - May be required to provide assistance to other departments.
 - Occasionally may be required to work on other buildings not owned by Cree Nation of Chisasibi
 - Perform all other related duties as requested by immediate supervisor.



KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS & ABILITIES:

- Thorough knowledge of plumbing systems, fixtures, tools, and equipment.
- Knowledge of applicable plumbing codes, building codes, and safety regulations.
- Ability to read and interpret blueprints, diagrams, and technical manuals.
- Strong troubleshooting and problem-solving skills.
- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision.
- Good organizational and time-management skills.
- Ability to communicate effectively with staff, contractors, and the public.

EMPLOYMENT EXPERIENCE & EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS:

- High School Diploma (Secondary V) or equivalent.
- Journeyman Plumber Certification or recognized Plumbing Trade Certification.
- Additional training in building maintenance, water systems, or related fields is considered an asset.
- Minimum of three (3) years of experience as a licensed plumber.
- Experience maintaining plumbing systems in commercial, institutional, or public buildings is preferred.
- Experience with water distribution and wastewater systems is considered an asset.
- Valid Class 5 Driver's Licence.
- Ability to perform physically demanding work, including lifting, climbing, bending, and working in confined spaces.
- Ability to participate in emergency and after-hours call-outs when required.

EMPLOYMENT CONDITIONS:

- Work is performed in public buildings, mechanical rooms, crawl spaces, rooftops, and outdoor environments.
- Exposure to varying weather conditions, noise, dust, sewage systems, chemicals, and other workplace hazards.



- May be required to work evenings, weekends, holidays, and emergency call-outs.

SALARY RANGE:

- Permanent Full-time position based on a regular 40-hour work week.
- Salary: \$58,864.00 (minimum) to \$90,084.00 (maximum) annually, depending on education and experience.
