TITLE: HEAVY EQUIPMENT MECHANIC

LOCATION: PUBLIC WORKS – MUNICIPAL GARAGE

CORE FUNCTION: Under the direction and supervision of the Garage Operations Manager, the Heavy Equipment Mechanic shall be responsible for repairs and overhaul of gas- or diesel-powered buses, trucks, heavy equipment owned and the property of the Cree Nation of Chisasibi.

MAIN DUTIES:

- Perform necessary repairs to ensure safety operation of all Heavy Equipment;
- Able to do visual inspection, adjust, test and repair engines, steering systems, braking system, drive train, vehicle suspensions, exhaust systems and electrical systems;
- Able to read and understand work orders;
- Examine and inspect the Heavy Equipment and listen to operator's complaints;
- Isolating the systems or components that might have caused the problem;
- Able to locate the cause of faulty operation and repair it;
- Able to use testing equipment like diagnostic scanners;
- Test drive and refer to manufacturer's specifications and shop manuals;
- Able to dismantle the faulty components and repair or replace worn or damaged parts;
- Reassemble and adjust and test the repaired component;
- Do scheduled maintenance services such as oil changes, lubrications and tune-ups;
- Advise supervisor on work performed, general vehicle conditions and future repair requirements;
- Following a check list in ensuring that they examine each critical part of the Heavy Equipment;

- Review work orders and maintain records by recording service and repairs;
